## Suggested Itinerary:

### DAY 01 – PORTO ALEGRE/ WINE REGION (127 km)

Reception at the International Airport of Porto Alegre. Transfer to Bento Gonçalves, city that is known as the Wine capital of Brazil, quick city tour and accommodation. Free night.

### DAY 02 – WINE REGION

Full day dedicated to the “Vale dos Vinhedos” (Vineyards Valley) tour. The Vineyards Valley is a small area of wine production inside the Wine Region. It is characterized by a set of 23 small vineyards, which produce wine, juices and other products of excellent quality, some of them being awarded in national and international contests. It brings together peculiar characteristics of the lifestyle, cuisine and hospitality, besides all the history of hard work and dedication of the Italian Immigrant. Visit to the Vineyards and wine tasting. In the evening, return to the hotel. Free night.

### DAY 03 – WINE REGION

Visit to the “Vinhos da Montanha” (Mountain Wines region), other high quality wine production area near the city of Pinto Bandeira. Visit to the Vineyards and wine tasting. In the afternoon, continuation through the “Caminhos de Pedra”, (Stone Paths) memento of the Italian Immigration, with a different architectural type of stone houses and the living traditions and heritage of the first Italian settlements. In the evening, return to the hotel. Free night.

### DAY 04 – WINE REGION / PORTO ALEGRE (127 km)

Return transfer to Porto Alegre with a stop at the city of Garibaldi, Sparkling Wine capital of Brazil. Quick city tour. Visit to the Sparkling Wine cave where it is possible to observe the Sparkling Wine elaboration. Wine tasting. Continuation to Porto Alegre.
