The area around is filled with prime opportunities for you, like the Tabacon Hot springs, whose geothermal pool are warmed by hot streams which flow from the base of the volcano. Lake Arenal is a great drive as well. A road runs from the town of La Fortuna past a lookout point facing the northern side of El Arenal and continues around the lake and down to the Monteverde Cloud Forest. You could spend days exploring this part of northwestern Costa Rica.

Full of incredible beautiful beaches, peninsulas, bays and gulfs, this country is a very privilege site.

In this place, varied ecosystems live together creating impressive landscapes and unique scenic points that make Costa Rica the perfect paradise to enjoy exceptional holidays.

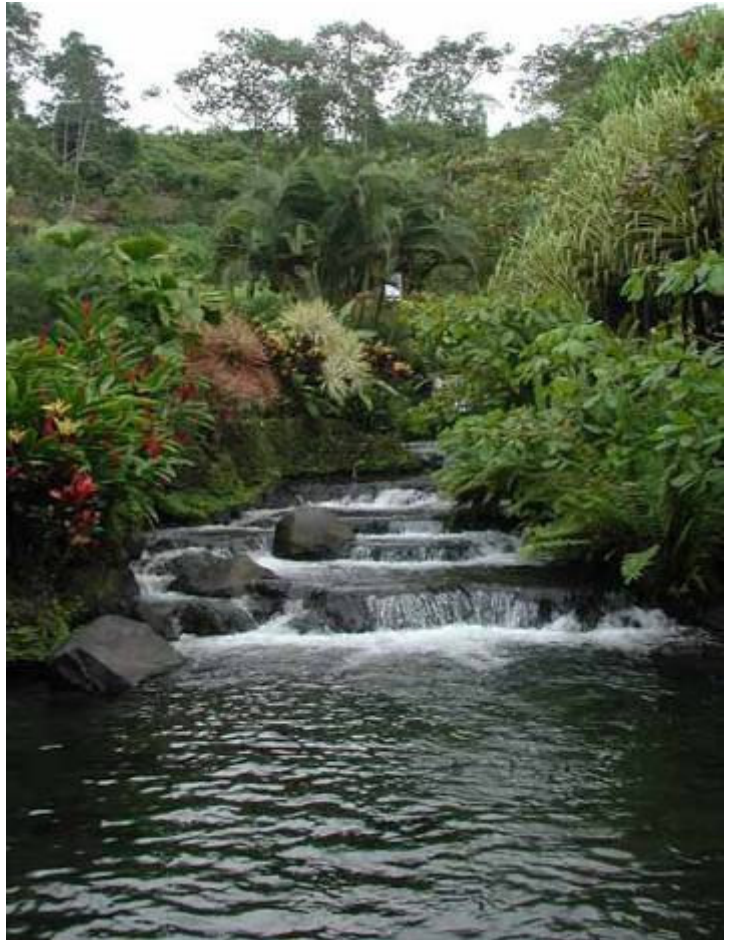
